

Getting to the River

By foot, step-free route (red route)

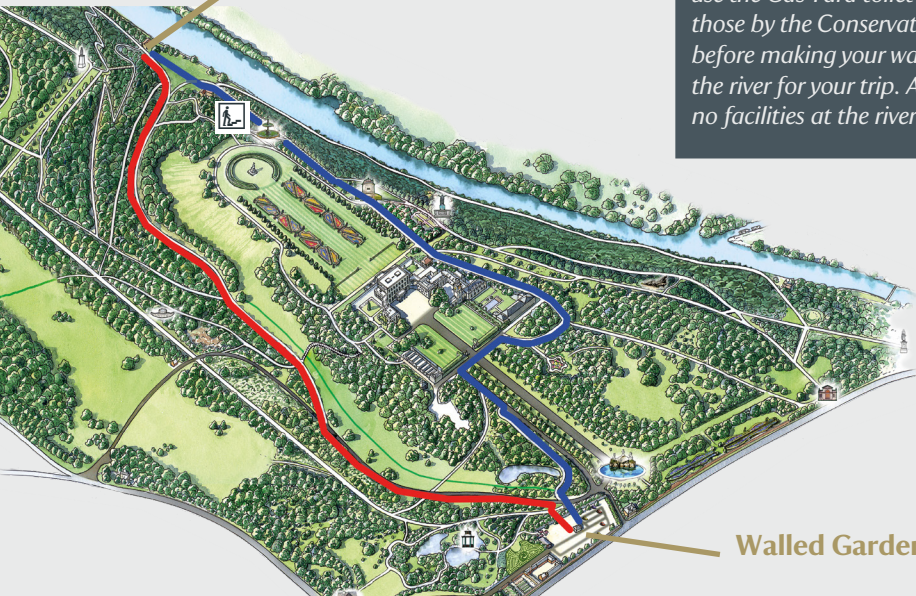
The red route is step-free, therefore we would recommend this route for pushchairs and any under 5 trikes and bikes. Please take extra caution whilst walking along the Main Drive with passing cars. Spring Drive is a tarmac road down to the river, and as Cliveden is upon a chalk cliff, this drive is steep in places and not accessible for wheelchairs. National Trust is currently unable to run any shuttle service to the river.

By foot, shorter via steps (blue route)

All boats leave from the Boathouse at the river, about a 30 minute walk from the Information Centre. The route includes 172 rather steep steps, however this is a short route in distance and time than the red route.

Please note - we would suggest you use the Gas Yard toilet facilities, or those by the Conservatory Café, before making your way down to the river for your trip. As there are no facilities at the riverside.
